

## Call to Artists

The Washougal Arts and Culture Alliance (WACA) is soliciting proposals from qualified artists (or teams of artists) to provide design and implementation services for sidewalk art. The objective is to create a series of paintings of a 3-D nature on the sidewalks of downtown Washougal that will be an attraction to local residents and visitors. Sidewalk "squares" vary in size, but 5X5 is common. Specific sites will be selected based on the individual design.

We are looking for individual artists to submit proposals for a single painting (or more) in the series. The paintings must be designed to create an illusion of depth, and can be whimsical - or challenging to the viewer's perception! Please see attached examples for inspiration.

We encourage artists who work in a variety of media to submit proposals, though the final product is intended to be permanent. Selection of the artist(s) will be determined by the WACA Board and will be presented to the Washougal Arts Commission for approval by the city.

Applicants must include the following materials as part of their proposal:


1. A brief description and color illustration of the proposed art installation along with approximate dimensions.

- 2. A proposed budget, including time and materials, for the project.
- 3. A timeline for the project.
- 4. Completed Artist Waiver.

Proposals will be accepted by WACA until March 15, 2025, reviewed as they are received, and the projects awarded by starting on October 1, 2024. Work is to be completed by mutual agreement with the artist, WACA, and the City of Washougal. Completion of the project is to be by the end of summer 2025.
